> DGCA to conduct special audit of Go First before revival plan

In the latest, the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) will conduct a special audit of grounded airline Go First's facilities in the national capital and Mumbai from July 4 to 6 before approving the revival plan for the resumption of flights, news agency PTI quoted a senior official. "After a preliminary review of the resumption plan submitted by the Resolution Professional (RP) for Go First on June 28, the regulator has planned to conduct a special audit," the official added.

Go First, which is undergoing a voluntary insolvency resolution process, had stopped flying on May 3. The special audit which is scheduled for July 4 to 6 will focus on the safety-related aspects. It will also pay attention on continued compliance of the requirements to hold an Air Operator Certificate. The focus is also on physical verification of the arrangements made for the resumption of flight operations," the official said.
