# CoC okays SNJ Distilleries' resolution plan for Empee Distilleries, awaits NCLT nod

The committee of creditors (CoC) of the debt-ridden Empee Distilleries has unanimously okayed the resolution plan by SNJ Distillers, part of the SNJ Group, a south India-based conglomerate and submitted it to the Chennai bench of the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) for approval. Four companies had shown interest in reviving Empee Distilleries, which is currently under corporate insolvency resolution process (CIRP).

## Indemnity to successful bidder under IBC: Finance Minister

Extending indemnity to successful bidders of loan defaulting companies, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Monday said the government will not launch any criminal proceedings against those who buy out a bankrupt company and no tax claim will be raised against them after implementation of a resolution plan. "The amendments were always brought in as a response to what was developing outside of Parliament where industries, creditors, courts, all of them were using the IBC to give solutions but there were greater, newer challenges which were coming up," she said.

# Cannot reject insolvency plea over claims disputed after demand notice: NCLAT

The National Company Law Appellate Tribunal (NCLAT) has asked the NCLT to decide over an insolvency plea filed against leading real estate firm Raheja Developers by one of its operational creditors.

Setting aside the earlier order passed by the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT), the NCLAT said existence of any "disputed claim" cannot be a ground to reject an application under Section 9 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC) to initiate insolvency proceedings, if it is not raised before issuance of a demand notice.
