The Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (IBBI), the regulator, would make regulations under the new regime for a principle-based, light-touch code of conduct for the representatives of foreign creditors. It will also provide for investigation and disciplinary action against misconduct by foreign representatives. The proposed new part of the IBC to deal with the failure of businesses with assets and liabilities in multiple markets marks a major improvement in the scope of IBC.
